In 2003, the District Board of Trustees of Florida Community College at Jacksonville (FCCJ) approved the General Education Requirements. The general education philosophy at FCCJ is

designed to prepare students to be thoughtful, effective, global citizens. Through exploring broad areas of knowledge – the global and historical; the cultural and aesthetic; the human; and the mathematical, scientific and technological – students will acquire the knowledge bases, develop the intellectual competencies, and be exposed to the values requisite for participating responsibly in a complex and diverse world.

In support of this philosophy, the mission of the General Education Assessment Task Force is to implement a multi-faceted process that will assess and document the students' acquisition of general education competencies in the areas of communication, critical thinking, scientific and quantitative reasoning, information literacy, and global sociocultural responsibility. The process will provide an ongoing review of FCCJ's general education curriculum with the aim of better meeting the academic needs of our students.
