This transfer institution has agreed to accept the specified associate's degree from Florida State College at Jacksonville. The Florida State College at Jacksonville graduate will be accepted at the junior level, and is required to complete the equivalent of two years of full-time coursework to complete the specified bachelor's degree. The following chart shows the specific courses that the Florida State College at Jacksonville student is required to take to meet the guidelines of the articulation agreement with the transfer institution.

It is very important to make sure that your Program of Study at Florida State College at Jacksonville is Associate of Science. If you do not plan to transfer to this specific transfer institution, please follow the Program of Study, as specified in the College Catalog.

Upon graduation from Florida State College at Jacksonville, Columbia College (CC) will accept up to 81 credits from any AS degree towards the BA Criminal Justice Administration. Students will complete a minimum of 39 upper-division semester credit hours from Columbia College to graduate with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Criminal Justice Administration.

- CLAS (College Level Academic Skills): The CLAS is a graduation requirement for the associate in arts degree in the state college system of Florida. Students must meet one of the approved exemptions – see the catalog for more information.
- The state foreign language requirement does not apply to students transferring to Columbia College.
- All General Education courses require a grade of “C” or above.
- Students will complete additional General Education courses at Florida State College at Jacksonville before transferring to Columbia College. Students must meet the CC General Education Requirements.

Prerequisite and Elective Notes:

- All prerequisite courses require a grade of “C” or above.
- A major prerequisite course may satisfy both Florida State College at Jacksonville General Education Requirements and CC Major Prerequisites.
Please review the General Education Requirements and talk with an advisor.
- Electives must have AS notation at the end of the course description in Florida State College at Jacksonville catalog.

Other Notes:

- No more than 81 semester hours can be transferred to Columbia College.
- Students must complete a minimum of 24 of the last 60 semester hours of Columbia College courses to satisfy the Columbia College residency requirement.
