This transfer institution has agreed to accept the specified associate's degree from Florida State College at Jacksonville. The Florida State College at Jacksonville graduate will be accepted at the junior level, and is required to complete the equivalent of two years of full-time coursework to complete the specified bachelor's degree.

The BA Criminal Justice Administration articulation agreement is designed for students in Associate of Arts or Associate of Science Programs. Upon graduation from Florida State College at Jacksonville, Columbia College (CC) will accept up to 81 credits from the AA or AS degree towards the BA Criminal Justice Administration. Students will complete a minimum of 39 upper-division semester credit hours from Columbia College to graduate with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Criminal Justice Administration.
