

Transfer Advising Sheet for General Studies Program

Associate of Arts or Associate of Science Degree

Articulated Program with Fort Hayes State University
Bachelor of General Studies

This transfer institution has agreed to accept the specified associate's degree from Florida State College at Jacksonville. The Florida State College at Jacksonville graduate will be accepted at the junior level, and is required to complete the equivalent of two years of full-time coursework to complete the specified bachelor's degree.

It is very important to make sure that your Program of Study at Florida State College at Jacksonville is Associate of Arts or Associate of Science Degree (any major). If you do not plan to transfer to this specific transfer institution, please follow the Program of Study, as specified in the College Catalog.

Upon graduation from Florida State College at Jacksonville, Fort Hayes State University will accept up to 64 credits from any Florida State College at Jacksonville AA or AS degree towards the Bachelor of General Studies (BGS). Students will complete a minimum of 60 upper-division semester credit hours from Fort Hayes State University to graduate with a Bachelor of General Studies degree.

General Education Notes:

- Please review the Florida State College at Jacksonville Catalog for General Education Requirements (GER).
- CLAS (College Level Academic Skills): The CLAS is a graduation requirement for the associate in arts degree in the state college system of Florida. Students must meet one of the approved exemptions – see the catalog for more information.
- The state university Foreign Language Requirement does not apply to students transferring to Fort Hayes State University, however FHSU may require foreign language coursework.
- All General Education courses require a grade of “C” or above.
- Students will complete additional General Education courses at Fort Hayes State University. Students must meet the FHSU General Education Requirements.

Prerequisite and Elective Notes:

- All prerequisite courses require a grade of “C” or above.
- A major prerequisite course may satisfy both Florida State College at Jacksonville General Education Requirements and FHSU Major Prerequisites. Please review the General Education Requirements and talk with an advisor.
- Electives must have the appropriate AA (for AA degree students) or AS (for AS degree students) notation at the end of the course description in Florida State College at Jacksonville catalog.

Other Notes:

- Students must complete the Information Literacy Assessment requirement prior to graduation from Florida State College at Jacksonville.
- Qualified students will have earned a grade point average of **2.0** and will have completed a minimum of 60 semester hours before transferring.
- No more than 64 semester hours of credit may be transferred toward completion of the degree requirements at FHSU.
- If you do not plan to transfer to this specific transfer institution, please follow the Program of Study, as specified in the Florida State College at Jacksonville Catalog.
