CLAST AND GENERAL KNOWLEDGE TEST Note for Teacher Education students:

- Students who are planning on enrolling in an upper division teacher preparation program must demonstrate mastery of general knowledge, including the ability to read, write, and compute, by passing the General Knowledge Test of the Florida Teacher Certification Examination, the College Level Academic Skills Test or a corresponding component of the National Teachers Examination series as one of the prerequisites for admission. However, the CLAST test will not be offered after June 30, 2009.

- All teachers must take the General Knowledge Test in order to receive Professional (continuing) Teacher Certification; therefore it is recommended that students who plan on entering a teacher preparation program and who receive a CLAST exemption from Florida State College at Jacksonville take the General Knowledge Test.

Other Notes:

- Qualified students will have earned a grade point average of **2.5** and will have completed a minimum of 60 semester hours before transferring.
- No more than 57 semester hours of credit may be transferred toward completion of the degree requirements at NSU, but students must complete at least 60 hours for A.A. degree requirements at Florida State College at Jacksonville (see approved list of AA courses above).
- If you do not plan to transfer to this specific transfer institution, please follow the Program of Study, as specified in the College Catalog.
