**Upon graduation from Florida State College at Jacksonville, Capella University (CU) will accept the associate of arts and associate of science degree as a block of credits towards the BS Technology.** Students will complete the remaining upper-division semester credit hours from Capella University to graduate with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Technology.

## General Education Notes:

- CLAS (College Level Academic Skills): The CLAS is a graduation requirement for the associate in arts degree in the state college system of Florida. Students must meet one of the approved exemptions – see the catalog for more information.

- All General Education courses require a grade of “C” or above.

## Prerequisite and Elective Notes:

- All prerequisite courses require a grade of “C” or above.
- A major prerequisite course may satisfy both Florida State College at Jacksonville General Education Requirements and CU Major Prerequisites.

- Electives must have the appropriate AA (for AA degree students) or AS (for AS degree students) notation at the end of the course description in Florida State College at Jacksonville catalog.
